The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No.125, dated 08.10.2019, under Sections 498-A, 406, 323 and 34 of IPC, registered at Police Station Moonak, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to order dated 12.07.2021, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation. He further submits that the parties have reconciled their differences and have since started residing together.

Report of the Mediation & Conciliation Centre of this Court has been received and the same also reveals that the dispute between the parties stands amicably resolved.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Balbir Singh, does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined investigation.

He further submits that he has instructions to state that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required in the case in hand.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 12.07.2021, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
