After arguing for considerable time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he could not place on record the report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. because the same probably was not supplied by the petitioner to learned counsel.

Given above, learned counsel for the petitioner wants to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file fresh one by placing on record the report under Section 173 Cr.P.C.

Consequently, the present petition is dismissed having been withdrawn. It is clarified that there shall be no necessity to file typed/translated copies.

Learned counsel further prays that given the family background of the petitioner, it shall be very difficult to procure power of attorney. Consequently, there shall be no need to file fresh power of attorney rather he may file the existing power of attorney along with the fresh petition.

It is also clarified that withdrawal of the present petition shall not come in any way of filing of fresh petition.
