This is a petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for quashing the FIR No.32 dated 05.06.2017 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 307 and 34 of IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 (Section 307 of IPC deleted and Section 336 of IPC added during enquiry), registered at Police Station Morinda, District Rupnagar and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-3).

A Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, on 04.03.2020 had directed the parties to get their statements recorded and the trial Court was directed to submit report with respect to the same.

The Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Rupnagar has submitted report dated 09.09.2021. The relevant portion of the said report

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is reproduced hereinbelow:-

“From the statements of the complainant Jai Singh and the accused Sukhvir Singh @ Lali, it appears that the compromise could not be materialized between the parties. As per statement of ASI Narinder Pal No.625/R, no accused has been declared as proclaimed offender in this case so far.
