GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J. (Oral)

The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of restrictions due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Petitioner-Parmal Singh, stated to be aged 41 years, has filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the impugned list of candidates dated 13.09.2019 (Annexure P-10) qua the petitioner, vide which the promotion of the petitioner from Lineman to Assistant Executive Engineer has been stopped.

Records of the case show that vide order dated 19.11.2019, notice of motion was issued.

Today, on the resumed hearing of the case, learned counsel for the respondents submits that in fact vide order dated 29.12.2020, the

petitioner has been promoted from the post of Lineman to Assistant Foreman. He therefore submits that in this view of the matter, the writ petition has become infructuous and no further orders are called for.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that an application i.e. CM-12149-2020, was also filed by him on behalf of the petitioner to amend the writ petition. He therefore submits that through the amendment *inter alia* orders dated 17.12.2019 etc., were also challenged which were passed during pendency of the present writ petition.

In view of the facts as noticed above, the present writ petition is disposed of as having become infructuous. The petitioner is given liberty to challenge such other orders including the left out prayer in the present writ petition, by way of filing a separate writ petition.

Ordered accordingly.
