This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.11 dated 11.01.2019 under Sections 21 & 61 Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substance Act, 1985, registered at Police Station City Dabwali, District Sirsa. The petitioner apprehended his arrest at the hands of Police, in the above FIR.

On 21.11.2019 the following order was passed:-

“Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.11 dated 11.01.2019 registered under Sections 21 and 61 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station City Dabwali, District Sirsa.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Arjun Singh Yadav, Asstt. A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. Copy of the paper book has been supplied to the learned State Counsel, who seeks time to complete his instructions.

Adjourned to 09.01.2020.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to appear before the trial Court and on such appearance, trial Court will release him on interim bail on furnishing of bail bonds by the petitioner to its satisfaction. However, nothing in this order shall prevent the trial Court from taking/concluding proceedings under Section 446 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 to be initiated/already initiated against the petitioner.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Naresh has stated that the petitioner failed to comply with the above order and as he was arrested in FIR No. 230 dated 20.08.2016 under Sections 15/16/61/85 NDPS Act, PS Kalanwali. After his arrest, the petitioner was produced in this case through production warrant and he was in custody. According to him, the petition is rendered infructuous.
