This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.164, dated 16.10.2019 under Sections 420, 120-B of IPC and Section 13 of the Punjab Travel Professional (Regulation) Act 2014, registered at Police Station Cantonment, District Police Commissionerate, Amritsar.

In this case, after notice of motion was issued, vide order dated 16.12.2019, a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court had recorded the statement of the petitioner that he will pay an amount of Rs.62,500/- to the complainant within one week from that day and on the said condition, the arrest of the petitioner was stayed till the next date of hearing.

On 20.02.2020, a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to implead complainant as party and bring a demand draft of ₹ 70,000/-, which includes ₹ 62,500/- as agreed by the petitioner to be paid to the complainant along with interest.

On needful being done, notice be issued to the complainant for 27.3.2020 through ordinary process and registered post on furnishing requisite number of copies of the paper-book, registered cover, process fee and incidental expenses, if any, within a week.

In case of non-compliance of this order in its letter and spirit, this petition shall positively be dismissed for want of prosecution.”

Neither the said demand draft of ₹ 70,000/- has been presented nor the petitioner has contacted the learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed for non-compliance of the earlier orders passed by this Court.
