The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.83 dated 19.10.2019 under Sections 406/498-A IPC 1860 registered at Police Station Tibber District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that it is essentially a matrimonial dispute between the parties and totally false allegations were levelled against the petitioner to the effect that the complainant was subjected to mental and physical harassment as he was unhappy with the dowry that was received at the time of their marriage. In fact, the complainant could not adjust in the matrimonial home as a result of which she filed the FIR in question. He further submits that pursuant to order dated 26.11.2019 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation. This fact is not disputed by the counsel for the State as well.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Rachpal Singh states that the petitioner is no longer required for further interrogation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 26.11.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
