The short affidavit of Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar (Mohali), filed on behalf of respondent No.1-State is already available on the file and is taken on the record. It has been mentioned therein that the Challan has already been presented against all the accused in the case pertaining to the FIR bearing No.94 dated 30.05.2015 registered under Sections 406, 420, 120-B IPC, on the basis of the complaint moved by the petitioner and that the departmental inquiry has also been initiated

against the erring police official, i.e Lakhwinder Kumar ASI.

Today, Mr. Satinder Singh, Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar (Mohali), has also joined the proceedings and he apprises the Court that the inquiry against the above-named police official has already been concluded wherein he has been held guilty and the said fact has also been recorded in his Character Roll.

At this stage, learned Senior counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the above-discussed facts and circumstances, the grievance of the petitioner stands redressed and hence, the petitioner does not want to pursue the instant petition any more as it has become infructuous.

Resultantly, the petition in hand stands disposed of accordingly.
