JAISHREE THAKUR, J.(Oral)

This is a petition that has been filed for cancellation of anticipatory bail granted to respondent No. 2 vide order dated 19.11.2018 in FIR No. 29 dated 05.07.2018 registered under Section 498-A IPC at Police Station Women Cell, Bathinda, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioner would contend that respondent No. 2 has violated the terms and conditions of bail allowed vide order dated 19.11.2018 and has gone abroad.

Per contra, learned counsel appearing for respondent State would state that respondent No. 2 has now been allowed regular bail by the Court below and challan stands presented in the matter.
