The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.240 dated 20.05.2018 under Section 370 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station City Narnaul, District Mahendergarh.

The operative part of the order dated 11.12.2019, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that two co-accused of the petitioner, namely Rahul and Ikram, who were arrested on the basis of disclosure statement made by one of the accused and faced the full length trial, have been acquitted by the Court of Additional Sessions Judge, Narnaul, vide its judgment dated 09.04.2019, by observing that identify of the accused persons was not proved, as no identification parade was ever conducted.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sushil, submits that the petitioner be directed to join the investigation.

List again on 18.02.2020.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in

pursuance to the order dated 11.12.2019, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from SI Atma Ram, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 11.12.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
