On 04.02.2021, the following order had been passed:-

“By this petition, the petitioner seeks the quashing of FIR no.0138, dated 21.09.2016, registered at Police Station Dayalpura, District Bathinda, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 341, 354, 354-B of the IPC along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise reached between the parties.

Pursuant to the order of this court dated 28.11.2019, the report of the learned JMIC, Phul, dated 13.04.2020, is on record, stating therein that the petitioner herein is the accused in the FIR in question and that no accused has been declared to be a proclaimed offender.

It has further been stated that the complainant in the petition, i.e. respondent no.2, Gurwinder Kaur, appeared before that court and stated

that she has compromised the matter with the petitioner of her own free will and that the FIR may be quashed, with the statement of the petitioner, i.e. the accused, also having been recorded in respect of the compromise reached between the parties.

As per the assessment of that court, the compromise has been arrived at of the free will of the parties.

However, since the Bar is abstaining from work today and even counsel for the complainant is not present to re-affirm the aforesaid before this court, adjourned to 10.02.2021.

Today, learned counsel for the petitioner and the complainant, i.e. respondent no. 2, appear before this court and reaffirm that the matter has been settled amicably between the parties.

Consequently, in view of the above as also the report furnished by the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Phul, also looking at the nature of offences involved, the petition is allowed and FIR No. 0138 dated 21.09.2016, registered at Police Station Dayalpura, District Bathinda, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 341/354/354-B of the IPC, along with all proceedings emanating therefrom, is hereby quashed.
