The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0123 dated 30.10.2019 under Sections 498A, 406, 506, 323 & 34 IPC (Section 4 of Muslim Act, 2019, added later on), registered at Police Station Women Cell, District Jind.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the matter stands compromised between the parties and the divorce has been granted. It is contended that on the direction of this Court, has joined the investigation

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Geeta, submits that petitioner has joined the investigation and that the matter has been investigated.

In view of the facts that the matter has been investigated and petitioner has joined the investigation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 29.11.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr. P.C.
