Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, who absented himself for one date in the proceedings of Appeal No.CRA-633 of 2017 and consequently his bail was cancelled vide order dated 14.10.2019 by the learned Appellate Court. The appellant was convicted and sentenced by the learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Bathinda in a case FIR No.63 dated 10.10.2013 registered under Section 406, 498-A IPC at Police Station Women Cell, Bathinda.

This Court vide order dated 2.12.2019, granted interim bail to the petitioner subject to his furnishing bail bonds and appear before the Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in pursuance to the same, the petitioner has appeared before Appellate the Court and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Tasvir Singh,
has endorsed the same.

In view of the above, the order dated 2.12.2019 is made
absolute and the petition stands allowed.
