The Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in FIR No.97 dated 22.10.2019 registered under Sections 406 and 498-A of the IPC at Police Station Women Cell, District Jalandhar, Punjab.

By virtue of the order dated 19.08.2021, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that in pursuance to the order dated 19.08.2021, the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel has endorsed the same and submitted that petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

Learned counsel for complainant has put in appearance through Video Conferencing along with the complainant in person and submits that recovery of some of the articles is yet to be effected.

On the asking of the Court, whether the matter be referred to the mediation, the complainant refused and submits that there is no scope of mediation in this case.

In view of the overall facts and circumstances of the case, the order dated 19.08.2021 is made absolute and the petition stands allowed.
