CRM-26482-2021

This is an application filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking preponement of the date of hearing of the main case, which is otherwise fixed for hearing on 21.12.2021.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, same is allowed and the hearing of the main case is preponed and the same is taken on board today itself.

CRM-26484-2021

Application is allowed, as prayed for.

Copy of compromise deed and the statement (Annexures P-6 and P-7 respectively) are taken on record.

CRM-M-954-2020

This is a petition that has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for modification/reducing/quashing of impugned order dated 26.08.2019 as

well as order dated 04.06.2019 passed in proceedings under the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act whereby the petitioner has been directed to pay an interim maintenance to the tune of Rs.10,000/- per month to the minor child.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner would contend that the matter in fact stands resolved between the parties by a compromise dated 22.07.2021 wherein it has been decided to settle all disputes. In the said compromise, it has been decided that the petitioner herein will pay an amount of Rs.9,50,000/- as full and final settlement against the claims of the complainant-wife and the minor child. It is submitted that as the matter stands compromised, the instant petition has been rendered infructuous.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the fact that the petitioner is not pressing the instant petition, the same is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous in terms of the compromise arrived at between the parties.
