[1] The matter is taken up for hearing through video conference due to COVID-19 situation.

[2] This petition was filed by Amarjit Singh and Paramjit Kaur seeking directions to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana and Station House Officer, Police Station Division No. 8, Ludhiana to protect their life and liberty from the hands of the private respondents arrayed in the petition.

[3] Notice of motion was issued.

[4] Reply dated 30th August, 2021 filed by learned State counsel by way of an affidavit of Jatinder Singh, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Civil Lines, Ludhiana is taken on record.

[5] During the pendency of present petition, petitioner No.1 (Amarjit Singh) has expired.

[6] As per the pleadings of the reply, petitioner No.2 has made a

statement that trial is continuing in cases of FIR No. 305/2018, under Sections 452, and 506 and FIR No. 316/2018, under Sections 457 and 380 IPC registered at Police Stations Division No.8 and 6, Ludhiana respectively. In view of the fact that private respondents are facing trial, petitioner No.2 does not want any action on the application dated 11th October, 2019.

[7] Learned counsel for the petitioners seeks liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law for the redressal of surviving grievances, if any.

[8] In view of the statement of petitioner No.2, no further directions are called for.

[9] Disposed of with liberty as prayed for.
