This matter is pending in this Court for availing parole by the petitioner to repair his house since the year 2019.

Counsel for the respondent-State would submit that in the interregnum, the petitioner has already availed parole on several occasions under various heads and, therefore, at the present moment, he would not be entitled for parole.

Reply has been filed as far back in the year 2019 wherein it had been stated that the house stands in the name of convict's father and the convict i.e. the petitioner resides in that house, and there are other persons

available to repair the house. It is also mentioned that the petitioner has availed parole 13 times during his conviction and also jumped parole on an earlier occasion.

Keeping in view the reply filed and the fact that the petitioner has already availed parole under different heads, no orders are called for in the instant petition and the same stands dismissed.
