The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 346 dated 28.12.2018, registered under Section 420 of the IPC at Police Station Model Town, Ludhiana.

The operative part of the order dated 06.01.2020, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Counsel for the petitioner has handed over a demand draft of Rs.1 lac and Rs.50,000/- in cash to counsel for the complainant, which is further handed over to the complainant, who is present in the Court.

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that as per the settlement, an amount of Rs.1 lac in the month of February, 2020 and the remaining amount of Rs.3.05 lacs in the last week of April, 2020 is to be paid.

Adjourned to 30.04.2020.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in

pursuance to the orders dated 06.01.2020 and 18.08.2021, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Partap Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 06.01.2020, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
