ARUN PALLI, J. (Oral):

Vide this petition under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. the petitioner prays for anticipatory bail in FIR No.220 dated 02.11.2019, under Sections 326, 325, 324, 323, 148 and 149 of IPC, registered at Police Sation Sadar Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

Upon hearing the learned counsel for the petitioner on 04.12.2019, this Court had enlarged the petitioner on interim bail:-

“Mr. Amritpal Singh Gill, Advocate appears, files vakalatnama on behalf of the complainant and the same is taken on record.

Contends that the injury attributed to the petitioner is on little finger of the complainant-Ajay Kumar. Also contends that regarding the same very occurrence, an FIR No.211 dated 21.10.2019, under Sections 452, 323, 324 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, was lodged at Police

Station Sadar Ferozepur, at the instance of petitioner's side.

Learned State counsel wishes to verify the same.

On his request, adjourned to 30.01.2020.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of his arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit him to interim bail, till the next date of hearing, on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioner is also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973”.

Learned State counsel submits that pursuant to the order dated 04.12.2019 (ibid) the petitioner had joined the investigation. Rather, he submits that upon an inquiry held by the respondent-authority a cancellation report was prepared/approved by the authority which has since been submitted on 08.09.2020.

In the wake of the above, the order dated 04.12.2019, is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition is accordingly disposed of.
