JAI PARKASH VS JASWINDER AND ORS

Both the parties are ad Idem that the appeal be disposed of in terms of consensus arrived at between the parties. Insurance Company has offered an amount of Rs.2,80,000/- over and above the amount already awarded by the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal.

Accordingly, in the light of understanding between the parties, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque for Rs.2,80,000/- in the name of the appellant with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within a period of four weeks, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on the enhanced amount of compensation with effect from the due date till final realization of the amount. On receiving the cheque from the Insurance Company, the concerned officer/official of the Lok Adalat Branch shall issue proper receipt to the Insurance Company. The appellant/appellant's counsel may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.
