A Coordinate Bench of this Court on 06.12.2019 had passed the following order :-

“Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.99 dated 03.03.2019 registered under Sections 420, 406, 120-B IPC at Police Station City Kaithal, District Kaithal.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that as per the allegations in the FIR, the petitioner is the Guarantor for the main accused – Sushil Kumar, who already stands arrested. It is further submitted that even as per the allegations in the FIR, which is based on an agreement between the complainant and Sushil Kumar, there was an arbitration clause and M/s. Shri Ramji Rice Land, Chandana Road, Kaithala, the proprietorship concern of Sushil Kumar, has already filed an arbitration case bearing No.6683 of 2018, praying for appointment of an Arbitrator and the same is pending.

In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating Officer within a period of 10 days to join investigation and he shall be released on interim bail on furnishing bail/surety bonds subject to the following conditions:-

- 1. He shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;*
- 2. He shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer; and*
- 3. He shall not leave India without previous permission of the Court.”*

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Sanjay, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the Covid-19 Pandemic, the order dated 06.12.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
