The petitioners pray for grant of anticipatory bail in case GD No. 024 dated 24.10.2019, registered under Sections 452, 323, 506, 427, 34 of the IPC registered as cross case at Police Station Division No. 1 Pathankot in FIR No. 0090 dated 21.10.2019, under Sections 323, 325, 34 of the IPC at Police Station Division No. 1, Tehsil and District Pathankot.

The operative part of the order dated 05.12.2019, vide which the petitioners have been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“It is contended by counsel for the petitioners that it is a case of version and cross-version. The main case is lodged by the side of the petitioners, on account of having suffered injuries at the hands of the other side. It is further submitted that no person is in custody from the other side.

Notice of motion for 27.04.2020.”

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners, in pursuance to the order dated 05.12.2019, have already appeared before

the SHO/Investigating Officer and have joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Babir Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners, vide order dated 05.12.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
