1. Prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.396 dated 22.10.2018, registered under Sections 323, 406, 498-A, 506, 34 of IPC, 1860, at Police Station City Dadri, District Charkhi Dadri.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 29.01.2021, the petitioner joined investigation, fully cooperated with the police, was released on ad interim pre arrest bail and that his custodial interrogation is not required.
