By way of the present application, the applicant-petitioner prays for incorporation of Section 201 IPC in the cause title as also in the prayer clause of the main petition, for the reason that such offence was added by the prosecution at a later stage than the ad-interim bail granted to the petitioner by this Court vide order dated 29.01.2020.

Notice in the application to the State.

Mr. Avtar Singh Sandhu, Addl. AG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of State of Punjab. He has no objection to the prayer made.

Accordingly, the application is allowed. Office is directed to incorporate Section 201 IPC in the cause title as also in the prayer clause of the petition.

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It has been brought to the notice of this Court by the counsel for the petitioner that the main case is fixed for 25.07.2021.

He seeks the indulgence of this Court to pre-pone the hearing to that of today and further prays that as the petitioner, in pursuance of the order dated 29.01.2020, has already joined investigation, said order may be made absolute.

The State counsel on instructions of Inspector Surjit Raj, admits the factum of the petitioner's having already joined investigation and, thus, has no objection to the prayer made above.

In view of the above, while directing that the ad-interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 29.01.2020, be also considered to have been granted for the offence under Section 201 IPC, added later on by the prosecution, the said order is hereby made absolute, subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
