Case taken up through video conferencing.

On 05.12.2019, a Coordinate Bench of this Court had passed the following order:-

*“Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that petitioner was not named in the FIR and that he has been nominated only on the basis of disclosure statement by the co-accused namely, Baljit Singh @ Kuku. Learned counsel for further states that no recovery has been effected from the petitioner and that he has been falsely implicated in the case. In support of his contentions learned counsel for the petitioner relies upon the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court rendered in the case of **Surinder Kumar Khanna versus Intelligence Officer Directorate of Revenue Intelligence; 2018(3) R.C.R.(Criminal) 954**, and the judgment of this Court rendered in the case of **Sant Lal versus State of Haryana;2019(1) Law Herald 848**.*

Notice of motion for 19.02.2020.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds/surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Mohan Lal, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 05.12.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
