The present petition has been filed seeking direction to respondents to grant the benefit of parole to the petitioner for a period of 30 days in terms of Section 3(1) (b) & (d) of the Punjab Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1962.

The petitioner in the present petition has averred that he was undergoing sentence for a period of ten years awarded to him by the Special Court Bathinda in FIR No.21 dated 23.01.2017 registered under Section 21 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station Raman Mandi, District Bathinda. Prayer of the petitioner in the present petition is that as he belongs to a poor family with two minor children, therefore, he be granted the benefit of parole for a period of 30 days.

After the notice of motion, reply has been filed by the respondent-State, wherein, it has been stated that the petitioner had filed an appeal against his conviction before this Court being CRA-S-1120-SB-2019

wherein, the further sentence of the petitioner has been suspended and the petitioner has already been released from jail on 23.11.2019 and, therefore, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

No one joined the virtual proceedings on behalf of the petitioner. Keeping in view the facts noticed hereinbefore, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition and the same is disposed of as such.
