This is an application under Section 340 Cr.P.C. read with Section 195 (1) (b) Cr.P.C. for initiating an enquiry against the petitioners for filing intentionally and deliberately false and frivolous petition by making false averments and pleadings and for filing the false affidavit in support thereof.

Learned counsel for applicant-respondents No.5, 6, 8 to 10 has submitted that he seeks to withdraw this application.

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In view of the statement made by learned counsel for applicant-respondents No.5, 6, 8 to 10, the present application is dismissed as withdrawn.

CRWP-1597-2019

This is a criminal writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction especially in the nature of mandamus to direct respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners.

None was present on behalf of the petitioners on the last date of hearing i.e., 09.08.2021. Today also, none is present on behalf of the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the State has referred to para 6 of the preliminary submissions of the reply in which it has been stated that there is no danger to the lives of the petitioners at the hands of private respondent Nos.5 to 11 and has submitted that the dispute between the parties was a land dispute and the same has been settled in favour of respondent No.5.

In view of the above-said statement of the learned State counsel, the present petition has become infructuous.

Disposed of as infructuous.
