The petitioner, who at the time of alleged offence was less than 16 years of age, has come up before this Court seeking anticipatory bail.

2. Vide order dated 19.12.2019, a co-ordinate Bench of this Court had granted interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner subject to the compliance of provisions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
3. The petitioner has annexed his school certificate, as per which, his date of birth is 21.11.2003. Aadhar certificate also corroborates the same date of birth of the petitioner.
4. Reply filed by Deputy Superintendent of Police, City-I, Patiala, does not dispute the age of the petitioner.
5. Given above, the present petition is allowed. The order dated 27.10.2021 is recalled the interim order dated 19.12.2019 is hereby made absolute.
6. There would be no need for a certified copy of this order for furnishing bonds. Any Advocate for the petitioners can download this order along with

the case status from the official web page of this Court and attest it to be a true copy. The Prosecutor shall also verify the downloaded copy by comparing it from the official web page. In case the attesting officer or the Court wants to verify the authenticity, such an officer can also verify its authenticity and may download and use the downloaded copy for attesting bonds.
