This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 92 dated 03.11.2019 under Sections 406, 420 Indian Penal Code, 1860 & Section 13 Punjab Travel Professional Regulation Act, 2014, registered at Police Station City Banga, District SBS Nagar.

On 06.12.2019 following order was passed by this Court:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the alleged payment of amount in the FIR, as claimed by the complainant, lacks all kind of particulars. He further submits that the dispute was previously compromised and states that the petitioner is willing to compromise the matter and compound the offence. According to him, a sum of Rs.35,000/- has already stands deposited in the account of complainant.

Notice of motion for 28.4.2020.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the

investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. ”

On 09.08.2021 it was apprised by the learned State counsel that the petitioner has not complied with the directions given by this Court and has not joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Mohinder Singh has stated that the petitioner has not joined the investigation till date and as per information given by the wife of the petitioner, he has left India.

Considering the above background and the conduct of the petitioner, no case is made out for grant of anticipatory bail.

Dismissed.
