Case has been taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing.

This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.595 dated 16.12.2018 under Section 302 of IPC, registered at Police Station Kundli, District Sonipat (Haryana).

Status report dated 30.10.2020 by way of affidavit of Virender Singh, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Head Quarter, Sonipat on behalf of respondent-State filed and the same is taken on record.

A bare perusal of above said report reveals that out of total

sixteen prosecution witnesses, fourteen witnesses have already been examined and the trial is likely to be concluded in near future.

Learned State counsel submits that earnest and sincere efforts would be made at the instance of prosecuting agency to examine the remaining witnesses on the next date of hearing fixed before the Trial Court.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that since material and majority of the witnesses have already been examined, Trial Court may be asked to dispose of the case in a time bound manner and instant petition be disposed of accordingly.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to Trial Court to make earnest and sincere efforts to dispose of Sessions Case titled “State of Haryana vs. Mohd Siraj”, F.I.R. No.595 dated 16.12.2018 under Section 302 of IPC, registered at Police Station Kundli, District Sonipat (Haryana) within period of three months positively from the next date of hearing fixed before the Trial Court.
