1. The petitioner has approached this Court seeking grant of anticipatory bail in respect of a case registered against him vide FIR No.180 dated 23.09.2019 at Police Station Bilaspur, District Yamuna Nagar, under Sections 323/325/341/506/307/34 IPC.
2. At the time of issuance of notice of motion by a Coordinate Bench on 09.12.2019, the following order was passed:

“It is contended by the counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner was released on bail in this very case. However subsequently, the police have added the offence under Section 307 IPC, as well, in the case. Accordingly, the permission to re-arrest the accused has been sought from the court. Hence, the petitioner apprehends his arrest. Still further it is contended that even as per the original version, no injury is attributed to the petitioner. The injury, inviting Section 307 IPC, has been attributed to the co-accused Sagar. In any case, the petitioner would join the investigation again, if so required by the police.

Notice of motion for 23.04.2020.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds/surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

3. Learned State counsel upon instructions has informed that pursuant to interim directions issued by this Court, the petitioner has since joined investigation and is not required for any custodial interrogation.
4. Having regard to the aforestated position wherein the petitioner has already joined investigation and is not required for any custodial interrogation, the petition is accepted and the interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 09.12.2019 are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
