Prayer in the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No. 1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and her family members at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 8.

Vide order dated 29.07.2021, the Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar Rural, was directed to file an affidavit as to how the police is contemplating forcible execution of the sale deed.

In compliance thereof, the Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar Rural, has filed the affidavit dated 16.08.2021, deposing therein that in terms of the agreement to sell dated 16.09.2019, a sale deed had been

executed on 31.12.2019. A civil suit filed by the petitioner qua the land in dispute is also pending adjudication before the learned trial Court at Jalandhar. He further undertakes to comply with any further order or direction passed by this Court.

In view of the aforesaid affidavit, learned counsel for the petitioner does not want to press the present petition.

Dismissed as not pressed.
