Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Petitioners have preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.434 dated 08.11.2019, under Sections 420, 498-A, 323 and 34 of IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Line Jind, District Jind.

By virtue of the order dated 16.09.2021, while granting interim protection, the petitioners were directed to join investigation. It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners have joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel has endorsed the same and submitted that

petitioners are no more required for further investigation.
