Petitioner Rahul, a juvenile-in-conflict with law through his father and natural guardian Desh Raj has brought the present criminal revision petition challenging the judgment dated 16.05.2018, passed by Addl. Sessions Judge, Fatehabad, vide which, appeal filed against order dated 11.04.2018, passed by Principal Magistrate, Juvenile Justice Board, Fatehabad, transferring the case to Children's Court had been dismissed. The revisionist seeks setting aside of orders passed by the Courts below, contending that they have been passed in violation of provisions of Juvenile Justice Act.

Notice of the revision petition was given to the respondent-

State of Haryana, which has put in appearance.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties besides going through the record.

The impugned orders/judgments passed by the Courts below are detailed and well reasoned. The law is well settled that the revisional jurisdiction of this Court is quite limited. This Court is to interfere only if there is an illegality or infirmity apparent on the face of the judgment/order passed by a Court below or the same is perverse and not otherwise. The impugned orders/judgments do not appear to be suffering from any illegality or infirmity much less apparent on the face thereof. The orders are certainly not perverse or passed in an arbitrary manner. There is no reason to interfere with the impugned orders by way of exercising the revisional jurisdiction.

Learned State counsel has informed that the trial is at advance stage inasmuch as the prosecution has closed its evidence and now the case is fixed for 15.01.2021 for defence and arguments.

I do not find any merit in the revision petition, the same stands dismissed.
