This is the first petition filed by the petitioner under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.144, dated 16.10.2019 registered for offence under Sections 307, 452, 188 IPC, 1860, and Sections 25, 27 of the Arms Act, 1959, Annexure P-1 (offence under Section 452 IPC has been deleted vide G.D. No.23 dated 02.11.2019) at Police Station City Jalalabad, Tehsil Jalalabad & District Fazilka.

Upon instructions from ASI Mukhtian Singh, State counsel submits that trial has concluded and the petitioner has been acquitted vide judgment dated 18.02.2020 and the instant petition has become infructuous.
