SUDIP AHLUWALIA, J. (ORAL)

Ld. State Counsel, on instructions from S.I. Gulab Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation but he is not cooperative inasmuch as he does not disclose the names of other persons involved in the occurrence nor the JCB machine could be recovered.

2. From her side, Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that no such occurrence as alleged by the complainant had actually taken place nor cheating took place on the basis of forged documents at all in the nature of theft/cheating having been committed, by the Police Authorities, subsequently, it could have only been a creation by the complainant herself, and as such there is no question of disclosing names of any of co-accused nor recovery of any JCB machine since the matter is two years old.

3. In the given circumstances, considering the age of the case and the long tenure of investigation conducted so far, the interim bail granted to the petitioner earlier on 12.12.2019 is hereby confirmed.
