The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 171 dated 13.11.2019, registered under Sections 420, 420-B of the IPC at Police Station Sri Muktsar Sahib, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

The operative part of the order dated 10.12.2019, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“It is contended by counsel for the petitioner that only role of the petitioner is qua allegation of conspiracy. However, there is no allegation that the petitioner received any money out of the said transaction. The entire money has gone to the account of co-accused Manpreet Singh. Still further, it is submitted that the petitioner is not involved in the crime, therefore, even the name of the petitioner was not mentioned in the FIR. In any case, the petitioner is ready to join the investigation.

Notice of motion for 29.04.2020.

As per statement of ASI Kulwant Singh, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above and considering the fact that petitioner is on interim anticipatory bail for the last more than one and a half year and he has not misused the same during that period, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 10.12.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
