Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 122 dated 10.11.2019 registered under Section 21 of NDPS Act, 1985 (later on offence u/s 29 and 29-A of NDPS Act has been added) at Police Station Sadar Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur.

Vide order dated 12.12.2019, passed by this Court, *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 12.12.2019 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurdev Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 12.12.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
