The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.155 dated 16.11.2019 under Sections 498-A, 406, 376, 511, 377 and 120-B IPC 1860 and Sections 3 and 4 of Muslim Women Protection of Rights on Marriage Act, 2019 registered at Police Station Women Cell District Yamuna Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that on account of a marital discord between the parties FIR in question was registered against the petitioner. He further submits that pursuant to order dated 04.02.2020, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation. This fact is not disputed by the counsel for the State as well.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Amardeep Kaur states that the petitioner is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 04.02.2020, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
