This is 2nd petition for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.46 dated 30.06.2019 under Sections 323, 506, 458, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Sandaur, District Sangrur, earlier one was dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to file afresh, as the petitioner has attached the wrong order.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 06.01.2020: -

“...Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the injury attributed to the petitioner is on left leg of the complainant. Learned counsel relies upon the order dated 30.09.2019 passed in CRM-M-41940-2019, vide which similarly situated co-accused

Paramjit Singh @ Joga had been granted the concession of interim anticipatory bail...”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Harjinder Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 06.01.2020 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
