The present petition has been filed seeking protection of life and personal liberty of the petitioner by providing police help in view of the threats from the private respondents.

The writ petition has been filed on 22.07.2019. On 25.07.2019 the learned counsel for the petitioner sought time to seek complete instructions. On 26.08.2019 the arguing counsel was stated to be unwell. On 14.10.2019 again a request for adjournment was made. On 19.11.2019 nobody caused appearance on behalf of the petitioner. On 16.12.2019 again nobody caused appearance on behalf of the petitioner. On 09.01.2020 again nobody caused appearance on behalf of the petitioner. Thereafter on 06.02.2020 this Court directed the Registry to inform the learned counsel for the petitioner by way of written communication with regard to the next

date of hearing and it was also made clear that if the matter is not argued on the next date of hearing, then appropriate order would be passed. However, on the next date of hearing again nobody caused appearance on behalf of the petitioner and the Registry was again directed to inform Mr. Vijay Kumar, Advocate by way of written communication/Email/Whatsapp message with regard to the next date of hearing. Thereafter on 02.11.2021 once again the Registry was directed to inform Mr. Vijay Kumar, Advocate and it was made clear that on the next date of hearing the matter will be taken up for hearing irrespective of the fact that the learned counsel for the petitioner appears or not. The Registry has also put up a note that the learned counsel for the petitioner Mr. Vijay Kumar, Advocate has been informed through email.

Today, again nobody has caused appearance on behalf of the petitioner.

In view of the aforesaid position, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
