Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.17 dated 26.09.2018, under Sections 406/498-A of Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Phase-I, Women Cell, Mohali.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 11.12.2018, petitioner has joined the investigation and the same is affirmed by learned State counsel that petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further custodial interrogation. However, learned counsel for the complainant opposes the submissions made on the ground that the entire recoveries are still to be effected.

It is evident that the petitioner was granted interim bail on 11.12.2018 to till date. As per the submission made by learned State

counsel, the challan has not been presented. This Court finds it appropriate that the investigation is held up unnecessarily and the trial should be allowed to be commenced.

In view of the above, interim order dated 11.12.2018 is made absolute.

Petition stands allowed.
