Prayer in this petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 8.

Reply by way on an affidavit of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar is filed in the Court and the same is taken on record. As per the affidavit, the statement of the parties have been recorded, wherein, the private respondents have given an undertaking that they have no objection regarding the solemnization of the marriage of Sahiba and Julfkar (petitioners) and they are free to live anywhere of their own choice.
