This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.1032 dated 23.08.2019, under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC 1860, registered at Police Station, City Jagadhri, District Yamuna Nagar. The petitioner apprehended his arrest at the hands of police.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has invited the attention of the Court to the order dated 20.12.2019, whereby while issuing notice of motion to the respondent-State, the interim protection was extended to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that in deference to the said order, the petitioner submitted himself before the

police and joined the investigation. According to him, the petitioner cooperated with the police authorities during the investigation and furnished requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer.

Learned State counsel, who is assisted by SI Ram Kumar, does not dispute this fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation. Learned counsel, on instructions, further states that the petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 20.12.2019 is made absolute.
