The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.132 dated 02.12.2019 under Sections 406 and 498-A IPC registered at Police Station Women, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the previous order dated 04.03.2020 of this Court, the parties have arrived at an amicable settlement and respondent No.2-wife had returned to her matrimonial home. He further submits that in compliance of order dated 25.08.2021, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel assisted by learned counsel for respondent No.2, on instructions from ASI Ashwini Kumar, has

conceded that in compliance of order dated 25.08.2021, the petitioner has joined the investigation and submitted that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required in the case.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 25.08.2021, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
