1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

2. Prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.265 dated 23.11.2019, registered under Section 21, NDPS Act, 1985, at Police Station City Moga, District Moga.

3. Learned counsel contends that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 18.12.2019, the petitioner joined investigation, fully cooperated with the police, was released on ad interim pre arrest bail and that his custodial interrogation is not required.

4. Learned AAG, Punjab, on instructions from *ASI Jagmohan Singh*, confirms that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 18.12.2019, the petitioner joined investigation, cooperated in the investigation, was released on ad-interim pre-arrest bail and his custodial interrogation is not required.

5. In view of the statement of the learned AAG, Punjab, order dated 18.12.2019, passed by this Court, is made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the terms and conditions enumerated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

6. Petition stands disposed of in the aforementioned terms.
