The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.103 dated 20.09.2019 under Sections 323, 354, 377, 406, 498-A, 506, 509 and 34 of the IPC registered at Police Station Women Jhajjar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he has instructions to say that the petitioner is not in possession of any document, much less, pertaining to the thesis of the complainant. He further submits that the complainant completed her Ph.D., much prior to the registration of the FIR and all the relevant documents were already in her possession and stood submitted before the authorities concerned. It has been submitted that pursuant to order dated 19th December 2019 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Suvesh states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further interrogation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 19th December 2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) CrPC.
