The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.940 dated 29.11.2018, registered under Sections 147, 148, 323, 427, 379-B, 420, 120-B IPC at Police Station Sadar Bhiwani, District Bhiwani.

The operative part of the order dated 30.01.2020, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioner, is reproduced as under:-

“...Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in respect of an occurrence dated 30.9.2018, the FIR came to be registered on 29.11.2018. Co-accused, namely, Brahm Parkash, has been granted anticipatory bail vide order dated 22.10.2019 passed in CRM-M No. 31657 of 2019. Another coaccused, namely, Sanjay Tanwar has also been granted anticipatory bail by this Court on 27.1.2020 in CRM-M No. 50265 of 2019.

Notice of motion for 6.4.2020.... ”

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 30.01.2020, the petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Anil Kumar, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 30.01.2020 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
