The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.124 dated 21.07.2019 under Sections 363, 366 and 120-B IPC 1860 registered at Police Station Majitha District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that a false case had been registered against the petitioners on the allegations that they had tried to forcibly solemnize the marriage of the complainant's daughter. He submits that in fact the daughter of the complainant had voluntarily left her house and joined the company of petitioner No.1. The factum of the complainant's daughter joining the company of petitioner No.1 of her own volition stands corroborated from her statement recorded under Section 164 Cr.PC. He further submits that pursuant to order dated 20.12.2019, passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation. This fact is not disputed by the counsel for the State as well.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Mukhtiar Singh states that the petitioners are no longer required for further interrogation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 20.12.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
