The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the event of arrest in FIR No.727 dated 26.10.2018, under Sections 363, 376-D, 506 of Indian Penal Code and Sections 25, 54 and 59 of Arms Act (later on Section 363 IPC was deleted and Section 365 IPC was added), registered at Police Station Nuh, District Nuh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is falsely implicated in the present case and on the direction of this Court, has joined the investigation. It is also contended that nothing is to be recovered from him.

Per contra, counsel for the respondent-State, on instructions from ASI Bhagwat Prasad, submits that the petitioner herein has been declared as innocent.

In view of the above, the instant petition stands rendered infructuous.
